Happy September! Good luck with the start of your new school year, wherever you are in the world. This is the first of our Monthly Updates, with recruiting tips and other important information. <u>Search Fairs</u> are now open. Check our <u>Fair Webpage</u> for the schedule and eligibility criteria for each fair. A list of the attending schools should be available by October for the early fairs. You must request an invitation to a fair via your dashboard (please do not email me). If you are not sure which fair(s) you should attend, check this document <u>"What Fair is Right for Me"</u>.

If you are located in Canada or near Toronto, we encourage you to register for the <u>Toronto Search Fair, Feb 10-11, 2024</u>. We are excited to be partnering with one of the top universities in Canada, to provide <u>one</u> premier international teacher recruiting event in Canada. News about our ground-breaking partnership will be announced in the coming months.

## **Pro-Active Recruiting Tips**

Here are some tips for your international job search.

- Make sure you receive the daily email updates. You can filter this to match just your job
  preferences, using the email preferences on your dashboard. Note: you cannot filter the email
  updates by region, only by position.
- Use our database to research schools and jobs (hint: you can "favourite" schools and create a list of your preferred schools).
- If you find a potential match submit an application! If you're not sure how to apply using the Search database or APLi, read <a href="How to Apply for Jobs">How to Apply for Jobs</a>.
- Your email application should be a condensed cover letter expressing your interest and
  explaining why you are a good fit for that school. Once you have a good template, you can
  apply to multiple schools with moderate effort. However, be careful with your copy/paste nothing is worse than saying ABC School is your dream school, and then accidentally sending it
  to XYZ School. If you would like us to review your cover letter template, just let us know.
  Read Cover Letter Tips.
- APLi. More and more Search schools are using APLi, which is a huge advantage for Search
  candidates. But if you come across a position that you found through the Search database, and
  the school then directs you to register with Schrole, or they direct you to complete their own
  online application, please let us know. Many schools will waive this requirement for Search
  Active candidates, or at least the references requirement, so save yourself a lot of time/effort
  and check with us first!
- If using APLi, make sure your most recent references are there. If not let us know we may need to hard-sync your accounts.

- Do NOT wait until the last day to submit your application! Always give yourself a 1-2 day grace period. This will avoid any confusion with deadlines and time zones. Note: schools may withdraw a vacancy early, if they find a suitable candidate before the posted deadline.
- Keep your profile updated! You can continue updating your profile in Active status (remember, your goal is to have the most complete and competitive profile possible). So go ahead and request additional references, revise your CV, upload documents and/or your criminal background check. If you want us to review your profile again, just let us know.
- Auto-Archived! You need to log onto your account once every 30 days or our system will automatically Archive you. If this happens, you will lose access to the dbase and schools will not be able to see your profile. Just email me and I will re-activate you immediately (this has to be done manually).
